This is a digitally reproduced version of the 1853 Wisconsin Gazetteer containing the names, location and advantages of counties, cities, towns, villages, post offices and settlements, together with a description of the lakes, water courses, prairies and public localities in the state of Wisconsin. Researchers interested in genealogy and or the history of mid 19th century Wisconsin places will find the vast amount of historical documentation in this book invaluable.

The 256 page book on CD is alphabetically arranged and contains brief historical profiles of the cities, towns, villages and settlements of Wisconsin in 1853. Wisconsin places and place names, many of which no longer exist in contemporary literature or on current maps are identified and discussed in this excellent early Wisconsin resource.
