The abridged Atlas CD contains high resolution (400 dpi) scanned images of vintage 19th century maps that are presented in Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF). All of the 1878 Wisconsin county maps are included on this CD, as are 106 city and village plat maps from this period.

Unlike many digital reproductions created from aged and worn originals, these scans are crisp, clean and completely legible throughout. The excerpt example maps of [Grant County](#) (274K) and the [Village of Lancaster](#) (245K) plat are representative of the content and image quality found on this Atlas CD.

Each atlas map includes the following 19th century features:

- * roads, railroads and canals
- * cities, towns and villages
- * post offices and government sites
- * one-room schoolhouses, churches and cemeteries
- * rivers, streams and ferries
- * race tracks, fair grounds and picnic groves
- * industrial sites, furnaces and mills
- * early homesteads and farms
- and much, much more

The Historical Atlas of Wisconsin may be an invaluable aid to Genealogists, Historians and researchers in search of 19th century Wisconsin places and place names. These early maps often contain many places that no longer exist or that have been obscured over time; the location of churches and cemeteries may assist genealogical researchers interested in locating the last resting places of ancestors.
